Net Financial Assets	You may calculate your financial assets by totaling the value of any of the following assets that you own: • a deposit as defined in section 4B of the Banking Act (Cap. 19); • an investment product as defined in section 2(1) of the Financial Advisers Act (Cap. 110); or • any other asset prescribed as a "financial asset" for purposes of establishing accredited investor status by MAS. For the purpose of assessing whether you are an accredited investor, please note that only the cash in your CPF account after setting aside the Full Retirement Sum in the Retirement Account can be considered	• Latest bank account statement; or • CPF statement (dated no earlier than 3 months)
